Over **1,500** club members participated in Skill Tech, internet safety and computer productivity software programming. Members were afforded access to computers for homework completion, special projects, research, disguised learning activities and games.

More than **1,600** Club members participated in Project Learn and Power Hour. These programs focus on developing self directed learners, improving attitudes towards learning, homework completion and retention.

Our Impact
65% of Club members earned A or A/B Honor Roll in 2015.
 Nearly **400** grades were increased by at least one letter grade in the 4th quarter of the 2015 school year.

Our Impact
 Over **640** Club members participated in community service projects, providing more than **1,500** hours of service to their communities.

56% of Club members ages 11-18 participated in character and leadership development Clubs known as Keystone and Torch Clubs.

857 Club members participated in Anti-Bullying programs and activities, taking a stand against bullying in the Club, at school and in their communities.
400 Club members participated in Youth for Unity. This program encourages diversity and addresses issues of prejudice and bigotry.



More than **1,680** Club members participated in Triple Play (health for the mind, body and soul) Daily Fitness Challenges, designed to increase the amount of time engaged in vigorous physical activity daily.

More than **1,300** participated in Healthy Habits programs focused on good nutrition.
 Nearly **65%** of teen members participated in Passport to Manhood and SMART Girls programs focused on self-esteem, healthy relationships, and personal responsibility.

Our Impact
 Over **1,400** Club members participated in SMART Moves (Skills Mastery and Resistance Training) programming.
92% of Club members demonstrate increased knowledge of the dangers of alcohol, tobacco, drugs and irresponsible/premarital sexual activity.
